Dr. Sabine Stricker-Kellerer is a leading international legal expert on China business, with over 40 years' experience on topics such as the establishment and restructuring of foreign investment projects in China, aspects of corporate structuring and regulatory issues, negotiations, technology licensing, and dispute resolution. In 1985, she was the first European lawyer to open an office in China. She frequently acts as arbitrator with various Asia related arbitration institutions. In September 2023, she was appointed by the German Federal Foreign Office as the German Co-Chair of the German-Chinese Dialogue Forum.
